FEE SCHEDULE FOR 2011

1. **Trailing Fee:** The trailing fee will be \$10 per rider, not per horse. Please remember to bring CASH, and give it directly to the person who is hauling your horse.
2. **Horse Fee:** The horse lease fee will remain \$35 for the day if the horse is used by one rider. However, it will be \$20 per rider if the horse is shared by two riders, and \$15 per rider if the horse is shared by three riders. Fairwinds leasers do not have to pay the horse fee-- it's a perk included in your monthly lease.
3. **Trainer Fee:** The trainer fee will be a flat \$25 per rider, regardless of how many riders share a horse.



TURNOUT LIST

Black velvet or suede helmet

White or light colored show shirt

Dark colored hunt coat (e.g., black, navy, dark gray, brown)

Light colored breeches (13 and older) or jods (12 and under): tan, khaki, cream or light gray

Black field or dress boots (13 and older) or black or brown paddock boots (12 and under); jod straps in black or brown to match paddock boots (12 and under)

Black gloves

Spring hair clips, like these:



4 hairnets to match hair color (13 and older, and riders 12 and under with hair too short to braid); 4 two-foot lengths of ribbon to match color of show shirt and hair braided in two braids (for 12 and unders with hair long enough to braid)

Clean, white shaped saddle pad (NO square pads!)

NO jewelry and NO eye makeup (these are safety issues!)

Sweat pants, pajama pants, or scrubs to wear over breeches to keep them clean

Oversized T-shirt to wear over show shirt to keep it clean
